WEDNESDAY, MAY 19th 2021

We are focusing on the WILD women, declaring the attributes that have been highlighted to us into our lives.

PRAYER 1:

Esther, a woman of prayer, fasting, favour and RESULTS, because she knows when to turn up the HEAT on hell.

Ah, let's turn the heat up on hell corporately.

SCRIPTURE: *“Then Esther bade them return Mordecai this answer, ‘Go, gather together all the Jews that are present in Shushan, and fast ye for me, neither eat or drink, night or day; I also and my maidens will fast likewise; and so will I go in unto the king, which is not according to the law: and if I perish, I perish.’”* Esther 4:15-16, KJV

We pray that we are women who know when to turn up the HEAT on hell with our prayer and fasting, we receive favour of God and men, and MAKE HISTORY.

PRAYER 2:

Anna, prophetic and powerful, persisting in diligent and protracted prayers and fasting, until she sees JESUS.

SCRIPTURE: *“Anna, a prophet, was also there in the Temple. She was the daughter of Phanuel from the tribe of Asher, and she was very old. Her husband died when they had been married only seven years. Then she lived as a widow to the age of eighty-four. She never left the Temple but stayed there day and night, worshiping God with fasting and prayer. She came along just*

as Simeon was talking with Mary and Joseph, and she began praising God. She talked about the child to everyone who had been waiting expectantly for God to rescue Jerusalem.” Luke 2:36-38, NLT

Still on the prayer and fasting matter: While Esther had a reason to fast, Anna didn't.

She was just a woman who LOVED God so much she devoted her time completely to prayers and fasting, and as such, she was highly sensitive to when Jesus was brought into the Temple, and just as Simeon showed up, she too showed up and recognized Him.

There is something that happens when we are women of THE SECRET PLACE. Who just keep nurturing our relationship with God, and love spending time with Him, even without a specific reason, and even when it is not a corporate call.

Anna was SO FULL of the Holy Spirit that she was guided by Him like Paul tells us here: *“Do not get drunk with wine... but be filled with the [Holy] Spirit and constantly guided by Him.”* Ephesians 5:18, AMP

Even Proverbs tells us that true drinkers don't drink small small.

“Who hath redness of eyes? They that tarry long at the wine; they that go to seek mixed wine.”

Revelation 12

“Whose eyes are bleary and bloodshot? It's those who spend the night with a bottle, for whom drinking is serious business.”

Proverbs 23:29-30, KJV and MSG

PRAYER 3:

Hannah, woman of FAITH, rejoicing at prophetic words spoken over her knowing that God's promise of PEACE always comes through (1 Samuel 1:9-18).

Ah, the quality of Hannah that God has highlighted to The WILD is one that is so easy to overlook.

SCRIPTURE: *“In that case,” Eli said, “go in peace! May the God of Israel grant the request you have asked of him.” “Oh, thank you, sir!” she exclaimed. Then she went back and began to eat again, and she was no longer sad.”* 1 Samuel 1:17-18, NLT

Hannah had NOT YET received the promise in the physical, but once a prophetic word (of PEACE) was spoken over her after she prayed, she started to rejoice and her broken heart and deep sorrow, gave way to JOY, and soon after, her baby came.

She had now, by prayer, committed her case to God, and LEFT IT WITH HIM. No wonder the Bible says:

“Don’t worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God’s peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.” Philippians 4:6-7, NLT

Hannah took her mind off her issue and put it in GOD and so enjoyed SHALOM SHALOM.

“Thou wilt keep him in shalom shalom, whose yetzer (mind-set) is stayed on Thee; because he trusts in Thee.” Yeshayah 26:3, OJB

PRAYER 4:

The Proverbs 31 woman, putting in the physical, mental, and spiritual hard work to do and thrive in the literal wonder that is her life.

Ah, the only thing I could think about as I prepared this was how this woman is just OVERWHELMINGLY INCREDIBLE 😊😊😊

Like, where do we start?

The chapter is an 'ideal portrait' and can be intimidating, but it is not in the Bible to make us despair and argue that NO SUCH WOMAN exists; instead, it is here to ENCOURAGE us to the absolute highest standards of our own lives.

The entire Proverbs 31 is on the menu but let me highlight the last verses:

“Her children respect and bless her; her husband joins in with words of praise: “Many women have done wonderful things, but you’ve outclassed them all!” Charm can mislead and beauty soon fades. The woman to be admired and praised is the woman who lives in the Fear-of- God. Give her everything she deserves! Festoon her life with praises!” Proverbs 31:30-31, MSG

So, go ahead and give her the credit that is due, for she has become a radiant woman, and all her loving works of righteousness deserve to be admired at the gateways of every city!” Proverbs 31:30-31, TPT

I saw a large red dragon with seven heads and ten horns, with seven crowns on his heads. His tail swept away one-third of the stars in the sky, and he threw them to the earth. He stood in front of the woman as she was about to give birth, ready to devour her baby as soon as it was born. She gave birth to a son who was to rule all nations with an iron rod. And her child was snatched away from the dragon and was caught up to God and to his throne. And the woman fled into the wilderness, where God had prepared a place to care for her for 1,260 days.” Revelation 12:1-6, NLT

“When the dragon realized that he had been thrown down to the earth, he pursued the woman who had given birth to the male child. But she was given two wings like those of a great eagle so she could fly to the place prepared for her in the wilderness. There she would be cared for and protected from the dragon for a time, times, and half a time. Then the dragon tried to drown the woman with a flood of water that flowed from his mouth. But the earth helped her by opening its mouth and swallowing the river that gushed out from the mouth of the dragon. SCRIPTURE: Malachi 1:6-14

Unworthy Sacrifices

“The Lord of Heaven’s Armies says to the priests: “A son honours his father, and a servant respects his master. If I am your father and master, where are the honour and respect I deserve? You have shown contempt for my name!”

“But you ask, ‘How have we ever shown contempt for your name?’

“You have shown contempt by offering defiled sacrifices on my altar.

“Then you ask, ‘How have we defiled the sacrifices?’

“You defile them by saying the altar of the Lord deserves no respect. When you give blind animals as sacrifices, isn’t that wrong? And isn’t it wrong to offer animals that are crippled and diseased? Try giving gifts like that to your governor, and see how pleased he is!” says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies.

“Go ahead, beg God to be merciful to you! But when you bring that kind of offering, why should he show you any favour at all?” asks the Lord of Heaven’s Armies.

“How I wish one of you would shut the Temple doors so that these worthless sacrifices could not be offered! I am not pleased with you,” says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies, “and I will not accept your offerings. But my name is honoured by people of other nations from morning till night. All around the world they offer sweet incense and pure offerings in honour of my name. For my name is great among the nations,” says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies.

“But you dishonour my name with your actions. By bringing contemptible food, you are saying it’s all right to defile the Lord’s table.

You say, ‘It’s too hard to serve the Lord,’ and you turn up your noses at my commands,” says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies. “Think of it! Animals that are stolen and crippled and sick are being presented as offerings! Should I accept from you such offerings as these?” asks the Lord.

PRAYER 1:

Spiritual maturity is a MAIN goal for us in The WILD and this can only happen when we are investing the time and energy into our own spiritual growth, and then in how we steward spiritual responsibilities and deploy our Gifts of the Spirit (GOTS).

No more leftovers, spoilt, weak, damaged, offerings of anything to our God. Like that Malachi chapter above says in Verse 14: *“For I am a great king,” says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies, “and my name is feared among the nations!”*

PRAYER 2:

We are ORDERLY DISCIPLINED believers, doing all things in a beautiful and orderly way (1 Corinthians 14:40, TPT).

“But if I’m delayed in coming, you’ll already have these instructions on how to conduct the affairs of the church of the living God, his very household and the supporting pillar and firm foundation of the truth.” 1 Timothy 3:15, TPT

PRAYER 6:

We pray for an ability to not just do, but SUSTAIN the demands of our consecrations, no matter what they are. In this Kingdom, we get nothing for starting, we only get rewarded for finishing the work.

SCRIPTURES:

“Then Jesus explained: “My nourishment comes from doing the will of God, who sent me, and from finishing his work.” John 4:34

“I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, and I have remained faithful.” 2 Timothy 4:7

“Tell Archippus: “See to it that you complete the ministry you have received in the Lord.” Colossians 4:17, NIV

“Now to Him Who is able to keep you without stumbling or slipping or falling, and to present [you] unblemished (blameless and faultless) before the presence of His glory in triumphant joy and exultation [with unspeakable, ecstatic delight].” Jude 1:24, AMPC

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 23rd 2021

GIVING GOALS One: Charitable Giving

PRAYER 1:

That we are extremely generous to the vulnerable and needy in the society. Those who cannot pay us back, but on their behalf, God pays us back.

One of our WILD Heroes is such an example here:

“There was a believer in Joppa named Tabitha (which in Greek is Dorcas). She was always doing kind things for others and helping the poor.” Acts 9:36

SCRIPTURES:

“If you help the poor, you are lending to the LORD— and He will repay you!”
Proverbs 19:17

“External religious worship [religion as it is expressed in outward acts] that is pure and unblemished in the sight of God the Father is this: to visit and help and care for the orphans and widows in their affliction and need.” James 1:27

And the early church was literally founded on the GIVING pillar. All the believers were in fellowship as one body, and they shared with one another whatever they had. Out of generosity they even sold their assets to distribute the proceeds to those who were in need among them.

GIVING GOALS Two: Funding missions and other kingdom projects

PRAYER 2:

We fund missions and other BIG STUFF for the kingdom. I may be obsessed with this scripture because this was all women.

SCRIPTURE:

“Soon afterward, Jesus began a ministry tour throughout the country, visiting cities and villages to announce the wonderful news of God’s kingdom. His twelve disciples travelled with him as did a number of women who had been healed of many illnesses and set free from demonic power. One of the women was Mary who was from the village of Magdala, from whom Jesus had cast out seven demons. Among the women were Susanna and Joanna, the wife of Chusa, who managed King Herod’s household. Many other women who supported Jesus’ ministry from their own personal finances also travelled with Him.” Luke 8:1-3

Like Jesus, there are many who are out there, going from place to place, spreading JESUS and are in full time ministry. They are building schools and churches, making the Bible available in local languages, giving water, rescuing victims of human trafficking, creating jobs, and more.

GIVING GOALS Three: Giving to spiritual authority

PRAYER 3:

We won’t just be women who are happy receiving and receiving but never sow to our pastors, leaders, parents and more.

Ah, this one is so key and we are making it a GOAL, too. The Bible is VERY CLEAR that our spiritual authority (which includes our parents) deserve carnal blessings from us.

We give UP to go UP!!!

SCRIPTURE:

“Since we have planted spiritual seed among you, aren’t we entitled to a harvest of physical food and drink? If you support others who preach to you,

shouldn't we have an even greater right to be supported?" 1 Corinthians 9:11-12

GIVING GOALS Four: Celebratory Giving

PRAYER 4:

This one is so key because we are social beings and part of what keeps us interacting is our generosity. The Bible tells us to: *"Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn."* Romans 12:15

So, when people are getting married, have a baby, build a house, lose a loved one, and other such things, we too are generous then. We can also host people at our homes for whatever reason and make it GOD ENCOUNTERS literally.

SCRIPTURES:

"Six days before the Passover celebration began, Jesus arrived in Bethany, the home of Lazarus—the man he had raised from the dead. A dinner was prepared in Jesus' honour. Martha served, and Lazarus was among those who ate with him. Then Mary took a twelve-ounce jar of expensive perfume made from essence of nard, and she anointed Jesus' feet with it, wiping his feet with her hair. The house was filled with the fragrance." John 12:1-3

"Afterward Simeon, a Jewish religious leader, asked Jesus to his home for dinner. Jesus accepted the invitation. When he went to Simeon's home, he took his place at the table. In the neighbourhood there was an immoral woman of the streets, known to all to be a prostitute. When she heard that Jesus was at Simeon's house, she took an exquisite flask made from alabaster, filled it with the most expensive perfume, went right into the home of the Jewish religious leader, and in front of all the guests, she knelt at the feet of Jesus." Luke 7:36-

37

PRAYER 5:

And finally, we too have money to ENJOY LIFE. We will travel for vacation, own nice homes that can host Christian events, eat good food, etc., without neglecting KINGDOM COME assignments.

Jesus also came that we may ENJOY LIFE.

SCRIPTURE: John 10:10

“The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows).”



WEDNESDAY, JUNE 30th 2021

The GIFT OF DISCERNMENT

Understanding, desiring and receiving the spirit of discernment.

The gift of discernment is one that gives supernatural insights into the realm of the spirit. Most people believe that this gift only discerns evil but that's not true; you discern every kind of spirit, good or evil. You also discern seasons and times.

SCRIPTURES:

“So, give your servant a discerning heart to govern your people and to distinguish between right and wrong. For who is able to govern this great people of yours?” 1 Kings 3:9, NIV

“And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying: The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation. And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.” Acts 16:16-18, KJV

PRAYER:

We ask for the gift of discernment... we identify the operational spirit in our environment and we embrace/walk in its revelation (a good spirit) or cast and destroy an evil one.

Discerning Relationships And Situations

At every point in our lives, we come in contact with people; some we permit into our lives, some we shut out but what's the basis of these decisions?

Some people say energy or vibes but we say discernment!

Some people may look right for us but they are not, they might even be in esteemed positions, may be even pastors and prophets.

Some situations seem like the saving grace or perfect deals but we need to be able to discern these things.

SCRIPTURES:

"I realized that God had not sent him, but that he had prophesied against me because Tobiah and Sanballat had hired him." Nehemiah 6:12, NIV

"Then the woman went to her husband and told him, "A man of God came to me. He looked like an angel of God, very awesome. I didn't ask him where he came from, and he didn't tell me his name." Judges 13:6, NIV

PRAYER:

We pray that we are rid of every form of wrong relationships, we see clearly the intentions of men and we walk into prepared and right relationships.

Discernment And Wisdom

When you're able to identify right from wrong even though it seems undeniably right, (the right set of people, intention or even your environment), the next thing you want to do is act on it and this is where the wisdom of God comes in.

SCRIPTURE:

“And of the children of Issachar, which were men that had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do; the heads of them were two hundred; and all their brethren were at their commandment.” 1 Chronicles 12:32, KJV

It's not enough to discern only, it is important that we know what to do with what we have discovered. Hence, we are praying for the spirit of wisdom. That we know what to do per time, we know how to handle situations, friendships, etc.

PRAYER:

We know how to walk away from environments that we discern to be evil, we know how to embrace and nurture the prepared people God has sent to us.


PRAYER:

And if I were to be so generous as to give away everything I owned to feed the poor, and to offer my body to be burned as a martyr, without the pure motive of love, I would gain nothing of value.” 1 Corinthians 13:2-3, TPT

PRAYER 2:

SCRIPTURES:

“Have this same attitude in yourselves which was in Christ Jesus [look to Him as your example in selfless humility], who, although He existed in the form and unchanging essence of God [as One with Him, possessing the fullness of all the divine attributes—the entire nature of deity], did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped or asserted [as if He did not already possess it, or was afraid of losing it]; but emptied Himself [without renouncing or diminishing His deity, but only temporarily giving up the outward expression of divine equality and His rightful dignity] by assuming the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men [He became completely human but was without sin, being fully God and fully man].” Philippians 2:5-7, AMP

PRAYER 4:

We pray that we serve from a place of a rested heart.

SCRIPTURE:

“And in the morning, long before daylight, He got up and went out to a deserted place, and there He prayed. And Simon [Peter] and those who were with him followed Him [pursuing Him eagerly and hunting Him out], And they found Him and said to Him, everybody is looking for You. And He said to them, let us be going on into the neighbouring country towns, that I may preach there also; for that is why I came out. [So] He went throughout the whole of Galilee, preaching in their synagogues and driving out demons.”
