WILD FAST

So, we are working and praying through 5M's God showed me in my own secret place:

Masterplan

Mastery

Men

Means

Manifest

PRAYER ONE: MASTERPLAN

Oh gosh, OUR WHOLE lives actually have a MASTERPLAN in heaven and God says as we STAY THERE aka TARRY IN HIS PRESENCE, He will start to let us in on it so that we live our lives ON EARTH as it is IN HEAVEN

Scripture 1

Now the Lord said to Moses, "Come up to Me on the mountain and STAY THERE, and I will give you the stone tablets with the law and the commandments which I have written for their instruction."

Exodus 24:12, AMP

Moses had to STAY THERE for 40 days and God gave Him the ENTIRE MASTERPLAN for building the Temple.


"Be sure that you make everything according to the pattern I have shown you here on the mountain.

And Hebrews reiterates that we should be living a COPY and PASTE life, but only from the Masterplan in heaven

[But these offer] service [merely] as a pattern and as a foreshadowing of [what has its true existence and reality in] the heavenly sanctuary. For when Moses was about to erect the tabernacle, he was warned by God, saying, See to it that you make it all [exactly] according to the copy (the model) which was shown to you on the mountain. [Exod. 25:40.]

PRAYER TWO: MASTERY

Ah, this speaks of the DISCIPLINE and CONSECRATION we MUST submit to and the women we must BECOME, if we are going to replicate that Masterplan in our lives.

We are going to MASTER and MORTIFY the deeds of our flesh, and gain the MASTERY and SPIRITUAL STAMINA to do EVERYTHING God shows us about our lives.

And every man that striveth for the MASTERY is TEMPERATE in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible.

1 Corinthians 9:25, KJV

Now every athlete who goes into training conducts himself temperately and restricts himself in all things. They do it to win a wreath that will soon wither, but we [do it to receive a crown of eternal blessedness] that cannot wither. Therefore I do not run uncertainly (without definite aim). I do not box like one beating the air and striking without an adversary. But [like a boxer] I buffet my body [handle it roughly, discipline it by hardships] and subdue it, for fear that after proclaiming to others the Gospel and things pertaining to it, I myself should become unfit [not stand the test, be unapproved and rejected as a counterfeit].

1 Corinthians 9:25-27 AMPC

We are NOT going to be LAZY and INDISCIPLINED then expect prophecies to FALL ON OUR LAPS. No, like athletes, we would STRIVE for MASTERY and be TEMPERATE in all things...

PRAYER THREE: MEN

Because we are not called to RIDE SOLO on this journey, God gives us GIFTS OF MEN so they can help us achieve all He shows us to BECOME and DO.

For every assignment, call, work, project, etx., from God, He also gives men.

David had his men to help him in all his many battles. THESE ARE the ones who came to David at Ziklag, while he yet concealed himself because of Saul son of Kish; they were among the mighty men, his helpers in war.

For at that time day by day men kept coming to David to help him, until there was a great army, like the army of God.

1 Chronicles 12:1, 22, AMPC

(You should STUDY the entire chapter. It is SO GOOD)

Moses had men handpicked by God to build the tabernacle

See, I have called by name Bezalel son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah. And I have filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom and ability, in understanding and intelligence, and in knowledge, and in all kinds of craftsmanship, to devise skillful works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in bronze, and in cutting of stones for setting, and in carving of wood, to work in all kinds of craftsmanship. And behold, I have appointed with him Aholiab son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan; and to all who are wise hearted I have given wisdom and ability to make all that I have commanded you:

Exodus 31:2-6, AMPC

Paul had men in basically every city he went to, to start, continue and complete his kingdom work and even to keep him encouraged...

(Sit and search for scriptures on this one)

So, whether mentors, staff, bosses, destiny helpers, financiers, correct colleagues and Comrades, friends, prayer partners, partners, mentees, teachers, domestic help, spouses, WHATEVER, we receive our GIFT of

MEN CUSTOMISED for the MASTERPLAN He shows us in every area of life

PRAYER FOUR: MEANS

Oh, very closely related to men, we need the MEANS to bring the MASTERPLAN to life.

Money, Favour, Goodwill, referrals, recommendations, a kind word, etc. Whatever we need as MEANS, God is more than able to GIVE not just ENOUGH but MORE THAN ENOUGH.

Moses gave them the materials donated by the people of Israel as sacred offerings for the completion of the sanctuary. But the people continued to bring additional gifts each morning. Finally the craftsmen who were working on the sanctuary left their work. They went to Moses and reported, "The people have given more than enough materials to complete the job the Lord has commanded us to do!" So, Moses gave the command, and this message was sent throughout the camp: "Men and women, don't prepare any more gifts for the sanctuary. We have enough!" So the people stopped bringing their sacred offerings. Their contributions were more than enough to complete the whole project.

Exodus 36:3-7, NLT

At the moment I have all I need—and more! I am generously supplied with the gifts you sent me with Epaphroditus. They are a sweet-smelling sacrifice that is acceptable and pleasing to God.

Philippians 4:18, NLT

Then the family leaders, the leaders of the tribes of Israel, the generals and captains of the army, and the king's administrative officers all gave willingly. For the construction of the Temple of God, they gave about 188 tons of gold, 10,000 gold coins, 375 tons of silver, 675 tons of bronze, and 3,750 tons of iron. They also contributed numerous precious stones, which were deposited in the treasury of the house of the Lord under the care of Jehiel, a descendant of Gershon. The people rejoiced over the offerings, for they had given freely and wholeheartedly to the Lord, and King David was filled with joy.

1 Chronicles 29:6-9, NLT

And people from as far away as Issachar, Zebulun, and Naphtali brought food on donkeys, camels, mules, and oxen. Vast supplies of flour, fig cakes, clusters of raisins, wine, olive oil, cattle, sheep, and goats were brought to the celebration. There was great joy throughout the land of Israel.

1 Chronicles 12:40, NLT

(Let me stop here because I am about to put the whole Bible down here)

The koko is, God sends MEANS for the MASTERPLAN. He never leaves us STRANDED.

PRAYER FIVE: MANIFEST

Ah this is the LITERAL PRESENCE of God, endorsing us and giving us RESULTS that everyone sees and glorifies God for on our behalf.

If we have received a MASTERPLAN from Him, shown MASTERY, stewarded the gift of MEN and MEANS He has given us well as we walked out the plan, He then crowns all our effort with the MANIFESTATION of His glorious presence.

I find it absolutely mind blowing that the SAME THING happened for Moses and Solomon as they completed the Temple according to the MASTERPLAN

Then he hung the curtains forming the courtyard around the Tabernacle and the altar. And he set up the curtain at the entrance of the courtyard. So, at last Moses finished the work. Then the cloud covered the Tabernacle, and the glory of the Lord filled the Tabernacle. Moses could no longer enter the Tabernacle because the cloud had settled down over it, and the glory of the Lord filled the Tabernacle. Now whenever the cloud lifted from the Tabernacle, the people of Israel would set out on their journey, following it. But if the cloud did not rise, they remained where they were until it lifted. The cloud of the Lord hovered over the Tabernacle during the day, and at night fire glowed inside the cloud so the whole family of Israel could see it. This continued throughout all their journeys.

Exodus 40:33-38, NLT

So, Solomon finished all his work on the Temple of the Lord... The trumpeters and singers performed together in unison to praise and

give thanks to the Lord. Accompanied by trumpets, cymbals, and other instruments, they raised their voices and praised the Lord with these words: "He is good! His faithful love endures forever!" At that moment a thick cloud filled the Temple of the Lord. The priests could not continue their service because of the cloud, for the glorious presence of the Lord filled the Temple of God.

2 Chronicles 5:1, 13-14, NLT

PHEW!

The Hebrew word for this **GLORIOUS MANIFEST PRESENCE** of God in both places is **CHABOD** and it literally means **HEAVY** or **WEIGHTY**

Kabayaaaaaaaaaaaa



That *God* will show up in our lives in a **HEAVY TANGIBLE UNMISSABLE** way giving us results that we can't even argue with.

Ah!!!

Now, I know why Papa Hagin, Shambach and all the GENERALS of Faith
I am living my life to be listed with talk about living a FASTED LIFE!!!

That level where, as our default, we are steady, with the help of the
Holy Spirit, MORTIFYING the deeds of the wicked evil flesh!!!

And for Day 2 is going to be ALL ABOUT HIM, that is the Holy Spirit.

But H.I.M also stands for (wait for it) 😁😁

The

HOLY SPIRIT

IN

ME!!!



H.I.M!!!

Think about the endless possibilities as a result of the H.I.M?

Phew!!!

I feel like getting up and running around RIGHT NOW!!!

My only PROBLEM with this theme is how I am supposed to fit it into ONLY 4 watches. I mean, we could stay here for the next 365 MILLION YEARS!!!

Thankfully, our WILD FIRE FRIDAYS are starting NEXT WEEK so we get to dive deep into the Word, Prayers and More.

PRAYER ONE

The H.I.M first HELPS me to MORTIFY the deeds of the flesh and sets me FREE from the power of sin and death.

Just camp at Romans 8 and squeeze every SWEETNESS out of it, but let me highlight a few verses

And because you belong to Him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death.

Romans 8:2, NLT

So then, beloved ones, the flesh has no claims on us at all, and we have no further obligation to live in obedience to it. For when you live controlled by the flesh, you are about to die. But if the life of the Spirit puts to death the corrupt ways of the flesh, we then taste his abundant life.

Romans 8:12-13, TPT

See ehn, our God KNEW we could NEVER win this battle against our flesh, so He had to send His son JESUS to DIE, literally to pay the

PRICE for us, which now gives us the POWER to conquer a FLESH we could NEVER conquer on our own!!!

This is where we LAY DOWN all the weights, sins, strongholds and all that have hitherto held us down.

Every work of the flesh: Gluttony, Malice, Offences, Pornography, Masturbation, Lies, Jealousy, the whole works of the flesh (Galatians 8 has a laundry list)

We activate the COMBUSTIBLE POWER of the SPIRIT over them all, so we NO LONGER are ruled by it.

Kimon!!!

PRAYER TWO

The H.I.M now DIVES into the DEPTHS of God revealing to me the MIND OF MY FATHER about me; something I can NEVER KNOW in my own power or wisdom... SOMETHING THIS WORLDLY WISDOM CAN NEVER GIVE

The whole of 1 Corinthians 2 is serving all the GOODNESS here (READ.IT.ALL!!!) but permit me to highlight these few verses in the MSG paraphrase

We, of course, have plenty of wisdom to pass on to you once you get your feet on firm spiritual ground, but it's not popular wisdom, the fashionable wisdom of high-priced experts that will be out-of-date in a year or so.

God's wisdom is something mysterious that goes deep into the interior of his purposes. You don't find it lying around on the surface. It's not the latest message, but more like the oldest—what God determined as the way to bring out his best in us, long before we ever arrived on the scene.

The experts of our day haven't a clue about what this eternal plan is. If they had, they wouldn't have killed the Master of the God-designed life on a cross. That's why we have this Scripture text: No one's ever seen or heard anything like this, never so much as imagined anything quite like it— What God has arranged for those who love him. But you've seen and heard it because God by his Spirit has brought it all out into the open before you.

The Spirit, not content to flit around on the surface, dives into the depths of God, and brings out what God planned all along.

... We don't have to rely on the world's guesses and opinions. We didn't learn this by reading books or going to school; we learned it from God, who taught us person-to-person through Jesus, and we're passing it on to you in the same first hand, personal way.

1 Corinthians 2:6-10, 10-13, MSG

Kai!!! A DIVING spirit!!! And we are HERE FOR IT, depths and all!!!

PRAYER THREE

Oh, but after He dives and reveals, we need POWER to do... DUNAMIS!!!

That is another thing the H.I.M gives to us...

RAW POWER

DYNAMIC POWER

DUNAMIS

So now every righteous requirement of the law can be fulfilled through the Anointed One living his life in us. And we are free to live, not according to our flesh, but by the dynamic power of the Holy Spirit!

Romans 8:4, TPT



As you yield freely and fully to the dynamic life and power of the Holy Spirit, you will abandon the cravings of your self-life.

Galatians 5:16, TPT

And I especially LOVE the term DYNAMIC because it speaks of a FORCE characterized by constant change, activity, or progress...

It is NOT a STATIC one-size-fits-all package.

He changes into whatever I need Him to become per time so I can then DO!!!

So, if I need Him to give me ideas to feed myself and family well, He empowers me for that.

To wake up one hour earlier to pray? He was given for that.

To beat insomnia and enjoy a good night's sleep? YES YES YES!!!

Need to pass my professional exams? Of course.

Need to stop being tired and refusing my husband sex always? He GOTCHA!!!

Kick fear and start a business? He literally FUELS you

DUNAMIS!!! DYNAMIC!!!

Basically, He is at our SERVICE empowering us for any and EVERYTHING the Father wants us to do.



PRAYER FOUR

The H.I.M in me also now gives me DIVINE DIRECTION.

So all that dynamic power is not wasted taking me to Canada when God wants me to be in Qatar.

I am not on Instagram when the information that is about to change my WHOLE DECADE is waiting for me on Twitter.

I am not working in oil and gas, when he really wants me in the bank.

The H.I.M literally ORDERS my steps, ONLINE and OFFLINE so I am BANG at the right place at the right TIME, fulfilling destiny like I was born to.

I love the very simple but powerful verse that features Simon in the Bible, and it sort of pulls together all the previous watches on H.I.M

At that time there was a man in Jerusalem named Simeon. He was righteous and devout and was eagerly waiting for the Messiah to come and rescue Israel. The Holy Spirit was upon him and had revealed to him that he would not die until he had seen the Lord's Messiah. That day the Spirit led him to the Temple. So, when Mary and Joseph came to present the baby Jesus to the Lord as the law required,

Luke 2:25-27, NLT



The HS was UPON HIM, then REVEALED his destiny to Him, then LITERALLY LED HIM TO THE RIGHT PLACE AT THE RIGHT TIME to meet baby Jesus and fulfil that destiny.

I like how MSG puts it here

God's Spirit beckons. There are things to do and places to go!

Romans 8:14, MSG

And He is right IN US, leading us along the ride.

WILD FAST

Epithymeō

That's GREEK for DESIRES, CRAVINGS, and APPETITES

And that's the BIG FOCUS of our FAST this Week

For assuredly, I say to you that many prophets and righteous men desired to see what you see, and did not see it, and to hear what you hear, and did not hear it...

Mathew 13:17, NKJV

Many prophets and godly people in times past yearned to see these days of miracles that you've been favoured to see. They would have given everything to hear the revelation you've been favoured to hear. Yet they didn't get to see as much as a glimpse or hear even a whisper.

TPT

Here we see the passions and desires of these fathers of our faith was everything Kingdom but they didn't enjoy it cos no Holy spirit. So, we that NOW have the HOLY SPIRIT IN US, must truly have our PASSIONS on Kingdom and never the things of this world!!!

Don't set the affections of your heart on this world[a] or in loving the things of the world. The love of the Father and the love of the world are incompatible.

1 John 2:15, TPT

So we are going to be asking the Lord, literally just crying to the Lord to give us, His daughters, a PASSION and desire for KINGDOM and everything related to it.

Ok, so here we go for each watch

PRAYER ONE: PASSION FOR PRAYER

We hardcore ask the Lord to give us a STRONG DESIRE and PASSION for PRAYER.

Ah, gosh Sisters, we MUST love to PRAY for that is where we FORTIFY ourselves against the attacks of the enemy.

We will NO LONGER be tired or full of excuses when we pray but instead our prayer altar will ALWAYS be ON FIRE and BURNING for God, our

lives will be a mobile PRAYER MEETING with the Trinity and our normal language and default setting will be one of PRAYER.

Make your life a prayer.

1 Thessalonians 5:17, TPT

*The fire on the altar must be kept burning; it must not go out.
Leviticus 6:12, NIV*

PRAYER TWO: PASSION FOR THE WORD

Very closely related to that will be that we have a PASSIONATE PASSION and LONGING for the WORD OF GOD. I heard Apostle Orokpo say AND I COMPLETELY AGREE, that when Satan wants to attack and finish a man, he makes the word of God very unpalatable to Him. You pick your Bible and that's when you sleep off. You even have days without studying and reading the Word.

Ah No!!!

We are women who have a PASSION for the WORD. We run our lives based on EVERYTHING written in the Word of God.

*Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.
1 Timothy 4:13, KJV*

When I discovered your words, I devoured them. They are my joy and my heart's delight, for I bear your name, O LORD God of Heaven's Armies

Jeremiah 15:16, NLT (Had to burst out in tongues on this one)

Fill your thoughts with my words until they penetrate deep into your spirit. Then, as you unwrap my words, [b] they will impart true life and radiant health into the very core of your being.

Proverbs 4:21-22, TPT

PRAYER THREE: PASSION FOR HIS HOUSE AND PRESENCE

We ask for a **PASSION** for the **PRESENCE** of God. Oh, we **LOVE** the house of God and the gathering of Saints. And this is not only about Church, it is about loving to hang out with Believers and have conversations around kingdom, and not gossip.

That we **LOATHE** any gathering that is worldly, and we **CRAVE** the gathering of believers so we are edified.

We are **NOT** excited about parties, owambes, and co, more than we are excited about '2 or 3 gathered in **HIS** name'.

That in fact, we are so full of fire and passion that we literally transform every gathering we are to a **KINGDOM** one

*I was overjoyed when they said, "Let's go up to the house of the Lord."
Psalm 122:1, TPT*

My love for you has my heart on fire! My passion consumes me for your house! Nothing will turn me away...

Psalm 69:9 TPT

*They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity.
Acts 2:46 NLT*

PRAYER FOUR: A PASSION FOR TRUTH AND CORRECTION

Ah, this one I just need to STAY HERE, because I personally need it.

In a generation that is quick to interpret any correction as JUDGEMENT and always wants us to MIND YOUR BUSINESS, we have to be people who are PASSIONATE about TRUTH and CORRECTION with the Word of God.

For a time is coming when people will no longer listen to sound and wholesome teaching. They will follow their own desires and will look for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear. 4 They will reject the truth and chase after myths.

2 Timothy 4:3-4, NLT (Check this out in various versions too)

I am continually consumed by these irresistible longings, these cravings to obey your every commandment! The punishment you

brought me through was the best thing that could have happened to me, for it taught me your ways.

Psalms 119:20, 71, TPT

PRAYER FIVE

Yay, let's make this personal.

What do you currently need a recalibration in when it comes to your passions?

Maybe you need His help to desire healthy foods over junk?

You need His help to desire preaching videos over makeup when you get on YouTube?

You need to be **PASSIONATE** about **HIS PURPOSE** for **YOUR LIFE** as opposed to **YOUR OWN PURPOSE** for a life you didn't give yourself.

FRIDAY, 5 FEBRUARY, 2021

WILD FAST

We go a little deeper and a little wider, and this time, everything is PRACTICAL

So, for Day 3, Romans 12:1-2 in Peterson's MSG is the crux of it all, and we should HOLD ON TO IT for every watch!!!

So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him. Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you.

We are going to be taking 5 key areas of our lives and literally presenting it as an offering before Him, then asking Him to SHOW US our CONSECRATIONS for each area, meaning how does He want you to use it for His glory AND your ultimate benefit.

Consecration is a term we mostly associate with Priests and all those DEEP spiritual people, BUT that is who YOU, WE are!!!

I like how Bibles for America explains what CONSECRATIONS mean...

...Consecration is something that's reserved for a special category of people. But the New Testament reveals that it's something that every believer in Christ can, and should, experience.

Consecration is also not something only for knowledgeable or spiritually mature Christians. Rather, we all need to consecrate ourselves to the Lord in order to deepen our personal knowledge of Christ and grow in the divine life, even if we've only just gotten saved. This is because consecration is the basis for every spiritual experience.

So what is consecration? Consecration is giving yourself to the Lord to become "a living sacrifice," as Paul says in Romans 12:1

"I exhort you therefore, brothers, through the compassions of God to present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, well pleasing to God, which is your reasonable service."



So 5 areas we will be consecrating to the Lord for His Holy use, and asking Him to show us how His legislations for each in very practical ways

PRAYER ONE

Our SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES, which are the things we need to be doing to gain spiritual strength and stamina.

How and when does God want me to pray?

How and when does He want me to be fasting?

When should I take personal retreats? Where and how should I spend them?

Is there any spiritual discipline He needs me to start or stop?

I love how DETAILED this verse is. God told Him EXACTLY where He was going to be speaking to Him and WHEN too...

Set the Atonement-Cover as a lid over the Chest and place in the Chest the Testimony that I will give you. I will meet you there at set times and speak with you from above the Atonement-Cover and from between the angel-figures that are on it, speaking the commands that I have for the Israelites.

Exodus 25: 21, 22, MSG

While this is OT law, the principle remains the same and while God is OMNIPRESENT and can speak to us anytime, sometimes He wants to give us EXTRA SPECIAL instructions and would need to do it at SET TIMES and on HIS TERMS.

Even our Jesus had His moments where He escaped from everyone to be alone with God.

So when He says 'take a walk every day from 6am to 7am', we BETTER be ON THE ROAD then.

Or He wakes you at 4am, when the sleep is sweetest, WE BETTER be up and putting our legs in cold water.

When He says FAST every WEDNESDAY, we BETTER be binding that food and staying away from the kitchen.

If He calls us to a retreat once a month or quarter, we BETTER SHUT DOWN, GET AWAY and PLUG in.

Our God is many things, AND is also ADONAI... Our Master who wants things done how He wants things done.

So, here, let's ask Him about our SPIRITUAL consecrations

PRAYER TWO

DIET... Our food and lifestyle to gain SPIRITUAL STRENGTH.

Take your everyday, ordinary life—...your eating...

Romans 12:1, MSG

His food was locusts and wild honey...

Matthew 3:4

So whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God...

1 Corinthians 10:31

Oh, this one is so key because Satan uses this area to MESS a lot of us up. Food, when we don't have the right relationship with it, can easily move from ORGANIC to DEMONIC!!! Throughout the Bible, we see people who had special foods, being fed by God, or having a special diet

for an earthly king's service. That is because FOOD can be a TOOL in the hand of GOD or SATAN for service.

I mean, God Himself fed Elijah and that food carried him for 40 days.


This has been a personal game changer for me, because I literally use FOOD to ensure I am STRONG enough for everything I have to do, and not tired and worn out from excess crap consumption.

So how does God want you EATING? What does He want you to INCORPORATE into your diet or take out? How does He want you exercising?

When God is the creator of your MEAL PLAN, just know that you will be bristling with energy in your physical body every single day.

If Satan enters your diet, you will be weak, sick and too unwell to carry out all the beautiful things God has shown you.

Truth is real, dependable, right, sincere, and full of integrity.


Truth is at the core of God's character and LIES are the very nature and native language of Satan

Their belt was not this fancy thing we wear now for fashion. It was like waist trainer, ONLY MORE IMPORTANT!!

So we first of all install the 'anti-virus' of TRUTH into our system as we proceed on this battle.

PRAYER TWO

What lies have I been believing about my IDENTITY and PURPOSE?

Fancy and buzz words of Century 21 but very simply explained. Identity is WHO I AM; Purpose is WHAT I AM ON EARTH TO DO.

So where has Satan been lying to us about both that have caused us to shrink, hold back, be depressed, suicidal, joyless, frustrated and more?

What actually took place is this: I tried keeping rules and working my head off to please God, and it didn't work. So I quit being a "law man" so that I could be God's man. Christ's life showed me how, and enabled me to do it. I identified myself completely with him. Indeed, I have been crucified with Christ. My ego is no longer central. It is no longer important that I appear righteous before you or have your good opinion,

Galatians 2:19, 20, MSG

You need to go back and read that!

Paul is like I have tried to identify myself in many things - my job, my social media following, my bank account, my status, my friends, my marital status, and other viruses - and he kept falling short, until HE QUIT!!!

And installed the ultimate anti-virus!!!

I identified myself completely with HIM!!!

Kimon!!! We can do a whole dance on this one.

And Jeremiah extends the party hours by reminding us that even before we were born, we had a WHOLE PURPOSE

*Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you, before you were born, I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations.
Jeremiah 1:5, NIV*

And even the prophecy of John's birth pretty much tells us that PURPOSE is determined before we are born.

But the angel said to him: "Do not be afraid, Zechariah; your prayer has been heard. Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you are to call him John. 14 He will be a joy and delight to you, and many will rejoice because of his birth, 15 for he will be great in the sight of the Lord. He is never to take wine or other fermented drink, and he will be filled with the Holy Spirit even before he is born. 16 He will bring back many of the people of Israel to the Lord their God. 17 And he will go on before the Lord, in the spirit and power of Elijah, to turn the hearts of the parents to their children and the disobedient to the wisdom of the righteous—to make ready a people prepared for the Lord."

PRAYER THREE

The simple truth is that every man is in our lives for a specific purpose aka USE, and it is when we do not USE them for the right purpose that ABUSE sets in, and we start to be frustrated about the gift of men God gave us.

I love Ephesians 4:8

Therefore it says, "When he ascended on high he led a host of captives, and he gave gifts to men."

If He have gifts to men, it was not gifts for Jesus but gifts for US here on earth. It means that men are holding our gifts and it is through men we will enjoy the gifts of God.

My husband is a gift. My kids are gifts. My friends are gifts. My boss has my gift. My neighbour has my gift. My MIL is a gift. Everyone around me has my gift.

We need to start seeing the MEN in our lives from the eyes of the SPIRIT.

We are all imperfect gift-bearers but we are all gifts.

Satan is SKILFUL at lying to us about the GIFTS OF MEN in our lives and the purpose they are to serve. Then we get frustrated with unmet or misplaced expectations meanwhile there is a way Jesus wants us to SEE them and RECEIVE from Him through them.

And even when men choose to be used by the devil, we will not allow ourselves to be deceived by wicked hearts but we will see right through them and USE them in the way God wants us to use them, even when it means closing that door completely, or loving but from a healthy distance.

That KNEW there is *Ginosko* and that is the kind of INTIMATE knowledge between a man and his wife.

PRAYER FOUR

Every other thing is a CLEAR lie.

Not only is He our SOURCE, He is also the OWNER and we are STEWARDS so we have to use it exactly how He wants us to.

And because God is the source and sustainer of everything, everything finds fulfilment in him. May all praise and honour be given to him forever! Amen!

Romans 11:36

The MSG Bible puts it this way

Everything comes from him;

Everything happens through him;

Everything ends up in him.

It is when we believe the lies from the enemy that we start to misbehave in the stewarding of our time, work, money and all. That's when we start to place the thing that brings us money above the GIVER itself. That is when we start to build our lives around money, or take nonsense pride in it, or live like this world.

And it never ends well, like this rich fool.

But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' "This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God."

Luke 12:20-21

We need TRUTH about our SOURCE, resources and channels.

It could be your mind


It could be your body and weight

And how APT the theme for today: The discipline of PRAYER

The end of the world is coming soon. Therefore, be earnest and disciplined in your prayers.

1 Peter 4:7, NLT

MSG says, be WIDE AWAKE in prayer

NKJV says, be serious and watchful in prayer

TPT says, be INTENTIONAL, PURPOSEFUL and SELF CONTROLLED in prayer

CEB says, be SELF CONTROLLED and CLEAR HEADED so you can pray.

AMPC says, be SOUND MINDED, SELF RESTRAINED, and ALERT for the practice of prayer

You can find more versions and what they say about DISCIPLINE in prayer.

The truth is that PRAYER requires a TON OF DISCIPLINE.

Many of us talk about praying more than we pray, and like Myles Munroe rightly said, the prayer meetings in church are the scantiest, and we leave it only for INTERCESSORS. But drama night, worship night, cultural night, and so on are PACKED FULL.

Satan knows the power in prayer so he brings all kinds of stupid distractions, but, Haaaaaa NO MORE.

We are WOMEN of PRAYER so our FAST FOCUS will be on PRAYER. Asking God for and receiving the power to PRAY PRAY PRAY!!!

While prayer is not the only thing we are called to do, we all know that it is the FIRST place to start, and from that powerful place, the HS now shows us the right steps to take.

So we keep winning winning winning!!!

Ok so we go 6am, 9am, 12noon, 3pm and 6pm

Let's allow for 15 to 20 minutes for each watch and 30 minutes for the 6pm watch, where we also break bread.

PRAYER ONE

We will worship to SPIRIT PRAY by Elijah Oyelade

(Will share link and lyrics below)

Here we ask the spirit to super-intercede and pray through us as we plunge into this fast

Meanwhile, the moment we get tired in the waiting, God's Spirit is right alongside helping us along. If we don't know how or what to pray, it doesn't matter. He does our praying in and for us, making prayer out of our wordless sighs, our aching groans. He knows us far better than we know ourselves, knows our pregnant condition, and keeps us present before God. That's why we can be so sure that every detail in our lives of love for God is worked into something good.

Romans 8:26-28, MSG

And in a similar way, the Holy Spirit takes hold of us in our human frailty to empower us in our weakness. For example, at times we don't even know how to pray, or know the best things to ask for. In the same way, prayer is essential in this ongoing warfare. Pray hard and long. Pray for your brothers and sisters. Keep your eyes open. Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out.

PRAYER THREE

PRAYER FOUR

The art of planning and directing overall military operations and movements in a war or battle.

We need a plan, sis. We cannot just be shooting blanks. Thankfully, the Bible shows us how to be strategic in the prayer warfare with the WHOLE armour of God

Therefore, put on every piece of God's armour so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth and the body armour of God's righteousness. For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared. [e] In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. [f] Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all believers everywhere. [g]

"He never gave her the time of day. But after this went on and on he said to himself, 'I care nothing what God thinks, even less what people think. Last week, we focused on PRAYERS. This week we focus on, of course, THE WORD.

Oh, that we LOVE the WORD of God.

We are MADE of the WORD OF GOD.

We STUDY like SCHOLARS the WORD OF GOD

We PRAY the WORD of GOD

We have conversations STEEPED in the WORD of God.

Not only are we MOBILE ONE-MAN PRAYER MEETINGS, we are also MOBILE BIBLE SCHOLARS, not because we want to show off, or have some platform to teach others, but because it is just who we are and so it flows out of us (super)naturally.

Like we know, the VISION for us in this season in the WILD community is SPIRITUAL GROWTH, DEPTH and MATURITY so that:

...our immaturity will end! And we will not be easily shaken by trouble, nor led astray by novel teachings or by the false doctrines of deceivers who teach clever lies.

Ephesians 4:14 TPT

COME ON!!!

And one way to growwwwwwwww and mature is by doing business with the WORD!!!

So this FAST, (and when we pray on Friday), we do BUSINESS with the WORD!!!

Below are our WATCH focuses

PRAYER ONE

I just want us to start by being SO GRATEFUL that we have access, AS IN 100% ACCESS to the WORD, so we know what God is saying to us!!! Like we have the words of GOD canonized into this WONDER called the BIBLE, and we can just go to a store, buy it, or download online, and even have 100 copies if we want.

Then we have STUDY BIBLES, CONCORDANCES, DICTIONARIES, COMMENTARIES, GREEK AND HEBREW EXEGESIS and more.

Phew!!!!!!!

And then when we read, the SWEET HOLY SPIRIT is there to explain to us what we read.

When we think about how in the Old testament days, the Bible tells us SEVERALLY how they needed to depend on Moses, Samuel and the Prophets to tell them what God is saying, and had to wait for days before they heard from Him.

The boy Samuel ministered before the Lord under Eli. In those days the word of the Lord was rare; there were not many visions.

1 Samuel 3:1, NIV

All the people, experiencing the thunder and lightning, the trumpet blast and the smoking mountain, were afraid—they pulled back and stood at a distance. They said to Moses, "You speak to us and we'll listen, but don't have God speak to us or we'll die."

Exodus 20:18-19, MSG

Even as we see in the GOD'S GENERAL series, as recently as the 1300s, the BIBLE was for a select few who could interpret it anyhow and keep people in bondage, until Generals like John Wycliffe and John Hus fought to translate it and make it available for everyone, and they were persecuted and even killed for daring that.

Imagine a life without easy access to the Bible?

Today, look at our NEW TESTAMENT REALITY

But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach):

The Word became flesh and blood, and moved into the neighbourhood. We saw the glory with our own eyes, the one-of-a-kind glory, like Father, like Son, Generous inside and out, true from start to finish.

So please let us start with GRATITUDE, please.

And then ask for forgiveness for times when we have been CASUAL about a gift many Saints longed to have and some were KILLED for it!!!

PRAYER TWO

We pray that we TURN to the WORD first and nothing else to find answers, solutions and everything else that we need for life.

That as life hits us with everything life is designed to hit us with (trials, tribulations and co), we default to the WORD and we will find the LIGHT that we need. We are going to STUDY THE SCRIPTURES.

When people tell you, "Try out the fortune-tellers. Consult the spiritualists. Why not tap into the spirit-world, get in touch with the dead?" Tell them, "No, we're going to study the Scriptures." People who try the other ways get nowhere—a dead end! Frustrated and famished, they try one thing after another. When nothing works out, they get angry, cursing first this god and then that one, Looking this way and that, up, down, and sideways—and seeing nothing, A blank wall, an empty hole. They end up in the dark with nothing.

Isaiah 8:19-22, MSG

And just so we know, anything that replaces the Bible for us as a source of direction and counsel IS AN IDOL!!!

PRAYER THREE

Building up on 9am, we pray that we are DEXTEROUS students and scholars of the Word

We go DEEEEEEEEEEP!!!

We don't just read; we STUDY RICHLY and have God's WORD indwell us RICHLY!!

*Let the Word of Christ—the Message—have the run of the house.
Give it plenty of room in your lives.*

Like Daniel, we understand by studying the Bible what God is saying or has said about us and our loved ones...

man or woman of action. That person will find delight and affirmation in the action.

Don't just listen to the Word of Truth and not respond to it, for that is the essence of self-deception. So always let his Word become like poetry written and fulfilled by your life! Course Correction

First, who doesn't love a good story?

Or at least, the semblance of a story, lol.

So did you know that a plane has to be accurate to the tiniest degree if it is going to hit its desired destination? Sometimes, as much as 500 miles off course, AND the longer we travel, the further away we go. In some tragic instances, they didn't just end up off course, they ended up hitting a rock and everyone on board died, or landing in the sea, killing all.

A one-degree diversion is a matter of life and death, on a plane. Which is why we have to constantly be checking, not just the alignment and accuracy of an airplane, but the alignment and accuracies of our hearts

David is our model here. He recognizes that God is the only one who knows his past, present and future, and knows how his plane BETTER be flying, so that he doesn't self-destruct.

Lord, you know everything there is to know about me. You perceive every movement of my heart and soul, and you understand my every thought before it even enters my mind. You are so intimately aware of me, Lord. You read my heart like an open book and you know all the words I'm about to speak before I even start a sentence! You know every step I will take before my journey even begins. You've gone into my future to prepare the way, and in kindness you follow

behind me to spare me from the harm of my past. You have laid your hand on me! This is just too wonderful, deep, and incomprehensible! Your understanding of me brings me wonder and strength.

Psalms 139:1-6, TPT

He doesn't stop there. He then invites the Lord in to **COURSE CORRECT**.

God, I invite your searching gaze into my heart. Examine me through and through; find out everything that may be hidden within me. Put me to the test and sift through all my anxious cares. See if there is any path of pain I'm walking on, and lead me back to your glorious, everlasting way— the path that brings me back to you.

And because Satan is such a strategic foe, he never comes in obvious, heavy fashion. He, very subtly, attempts to veer us off, one small degree at a time

Small bitterness here

A little Instagram envy there

And boom, we find ourselves bang at the dining table of Satan himself, completely away from our divine path and destination.

Thankfully, the word of God is both our **LIGHT** and **COURSE CORRECTOR**. It shines light on our path so we see even the tiniest errors, then it course corrects us.

PRAYER ONE

We pray like David, using the same scriptures above, this time, the entire chapter. We just lay our whole lives before Him.

God, investigate my life; get all the facts firsthand. I'm an open book to you; even from a distance, you know what I'm thinking. You know when I leave and when I get back; I'm never out of your sight. You know everything I'm going to say before I start the first sentence. I look behind me and you're there, then up ahead and you're there, too— your reassuring presence, coming and going. This is too much, too wonderful— I can't take it all in! Is there any place I can go to avoid your Spirit? To be out of your sight? If I climb to the sky, you're there! If I go underground, you're there! If I flew on morning's wings to the far western horizon, you'd find me in a minute— you're already there waiting! Then I said to myself, "Oh, he even sees me in the dark! At night I'm immersed in the light!" It's a fact: darkness isn't dark to you; night and day, darkness and light, they're all the same to you. Oh yes, you shaped me first inside, then out; you formed me in my mother's womb. I thank you, High God—you're breathtaking! Body and soul, I am marvellously made! I worship in adoration—what a creation! You know me inside and out, you know every bone in my body; You know exactly how I was made, bit by bit, how I was sculpted from nothing into something. Like an open book, you watched me grow from conception to birth; all the stages of my life were spread out before you, the days of my life all prepared before I'd even lived one day. Your thoughts—how rare, how beautiful! God, I'll never comprehend them! I couldn't even begin to count them— any more than I could count the sand of the sea. Different times how we handle our relationships affects every facet of our lives. The bible has a litany of relationships that were not right, or were perfect, that led people away from God or led people to God. We see examples of relationships that were well managed and those that should not have been in the first instance.

But Lot, who went with Abram, also had flocks and herds and tents. So Abram said to Lot, Let there be no strife, I beg of you, between you and me, or between your herdsmen and my herdsmen, for we are relatives. Is not the whole land before you? Separate yourself, I beg of you, from me. If you take the left hand, then I will go to the right; or if you choose the right hand, then I will go to the left. Genesis 13:5, 8-9, AMPC

NOW JEHOSHAPHAT had great riches and honour, but was allied [by marriage] with Ahab. Ahab king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat king of Judah, Will you go with me to Ramoth-Gilead? He answered, I am as you are, and my people as your people; we will be with you in the war. And when the captains of the chariots saw Jehoshaphat [of Judah], they said, it is the king of Israel. So, they turned to

fight against him, but Jehoshaphat cried out, and the Lord helped him; and God moved them to depart from him.

Let us ask the Holy Spirit to guide us out of the wrong relationships, into the best relationships at each season of our lives. Let's ask Him to guide us to treating our friends' right.

Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love. Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace.

of a fool belches out foolishness.*



Fast Focus: Strategic Alliances

Simply, the Divine Relationships we all need!

From the Womb to the Tomb, we need people and not just any kind of people.

Now the Lord God said, "It is not good (beneficial) for the man to be alone.

Genesis 2:18, AMP

We were not designed to live life ALONE.

As much as we need people, there are SPECIFIC/STRATEGIC people that God has designed we need to do life with. God has ordained them in our lives for a PURPOSE. "There's a line of EQUAL FREQUENCY of those we must do life with." That's why we must stay sensitive in the spirit.

It is when we connect with God that he will highlight these relationships to us.

And when the Devil wants to deal with anyone, he ISOLATES them, but we are not ignorant of the devices of the enemy.

There are certain relationships we need to INVEST in to help us grow into mature Christians.

The 4 C's

Christ

Coaches

Catchers

Collaborators

PRAYER ONE

We start by thanking God for the existing relationships in our lives.

That is why the Scriptures say, "When he ascended to the heights, he led a crowd of captives and gave GIFTS to his people."

Ephesians 4:8, NLT

He knew we couldn't do life alone - so he left us with the gift of men. We thank him for the GIFTS of men around us. Our parents, teachers, mentors, friends, bosses, pastors, etc. Anyone and everyone that we do life with and has been a blessing to us...

Then we ask him to show us how we can maximize the existing relationships we have. Some of us have brought a lot of "see finish" into divinely orchestrated relationships. We repent and ask God to show us specific ways to maximize these relationships and benefit fully from it.

My dear brothers and sisters, I am fully convinced of your genuine spirituality. I know that each of you is stuffed full of God's goodness, that you are richly supplied with all kinds of revelation-knowledge, and that you are empowered to effectively instruct one another.

Romans 15:14, TPT

PRAYER TWO: Clarifiers and Coaches

People that have gone ahead of us. i.e., "Someone's whose Hindsight has become your foresight". Our Fathers, forerunners, mentors, inspirers, teachers, pastors, etc.

We need these kinds of relationships in our lives because they are WISER and MORE EXPERIENCED than us. They are so important in helping us navigate our times and seasons. And mentoring is an amazing way of raising us up into MATURE Christian disciples within the Body of Christ - so we can't joke with this. We need them to TEACH/GUIDE/LEAD us.

Without consultation and wise advice, plans are frustrated, but with many counsellors they are established and succeed.

Proverbs 15:22, AMP

Another version says:

"in the Multitude of Counsellors, they are established"

You can't miss it when you are surrounded by a multitude of Godly Counsellors.

When the lovers of God teach you truth, a fountain of life opens up within you, and their wise instruction will deliver you from the ways of death.

Proverbs 13:14, TPT

Yes, the Holy Spirit teaches you all things but someone will have to teach you about the Holy Spirit. When you are taught the TRUTH, a fountain of life opens up within you 🔥🔥🔥

We pray for God to highlight these relationships to us.

Even though the term "mentor" is not in the Bible, throughout the bible we see different "mentoring" relationships:

- Jethro (Moses father-in-law) mentored Moses.
- Moses mentored Joshua.
- Eli mentored Samuel.
- Samuel mentored Saul and David. Ahithophel and Nathan the prophet also mentored David.
- David mentored his army commanders and government officials to establish the united nation of Israel.
- David also mentored Solomon.
- Solomon mentored the Queen of Sheba, who returned to her people with his wisdom in the form of Proverbs that applied God's laws.
- Elisha was prepared for his prophetic ministry because of his close relationship with Elijah.
- Naomi mentored Ruth.
- Paul mentored Timothy.
- Elizabeth mentored Mary.

Just some examples and we see even Jesus Christ closely mentoring his disciples. We see that there is a CHAIN of on-going mentoring, there is a flow in the spirit. These relationships are divinely orchestrated and passed from one generation to another

Don't forget the example of your spiritual leaders who have spoken God's messages to you, take a close look at how their lives ended, and then follow their walk of faith.

Hebrews 13:7, TPT

Remember your leaders who taught you the word of God. Think of all the good that has come from their lives, and follow the example of their faith.

Hebrews 13:7, NLT

PRAYER THREE: Collaborators.

Your friends, family, partners, colleagues and the likes. They give us leverage and direction.

When you partner with these people you go FAR-ther. When you are with the right collaborators they synergize, encourage and strengthen you!!!

I love this scripture in proverbs that says.

As iron sharpens iron, so one man sharpens [and influences] another [through discussion].

Proverbs 27:17, AMP

And here in Ecclesiastes

Two are better than one because they have a good return for their hard work. If either should fall, one can pick up the other. But how miserable are those who fall and don't have a companion to help them up!

Ecclesiastes 4:9-10, CEB

Jonathan was a major partner in David's life, they also had a CONVENANT relationship. We see how Jonathan encouraged David and helped him find strength in God. Their relationship was a blessing to both of them.


And Jonathan, Saul's son, arose and went [into the woods] to David at Horesh, and encouraged him in God.

And so we must INFLUENCE them the right way because these set of people are watching us.

We SOW into our catchers' godly counsel, knowledge, wisdom, time, listening ears, direction.

We pray that God shows us how to influence those before us in a godly way

Dedicate your children to God and point them in the way that they should go, and the values they've learned from you will be with them for life.

Proverbs 22:6, TPT

I love how the TPT version says the VALUES they've learnt from you will be with them for life!!! They won't learn these things and drop it off. It stays with them for life.

And let us consider and give attentive, continuous care to watching over one another, studying how we may stir up (stimulate and incite) to love and helpful deeds and noble activities, Not forsaking or neglecting to assemble together [as believers], as is the habit of some people, but admonishing (warning, urging, and encouraging) one another, and all the more faithfully as you see the day approaching.

Hebrews 10:24-25, AMPC

A perfect example we see is Paul to Timothy - in fact Paul describes Timothy as being "like-minded" to him in his commitment to serving God. That is GOALS!!!

Their relationship was so strong that Paul called it a father-son relationship. Paul INVESTED in Timothy that's why there were results evident in his life.

If we invest in our catchers well, they soon rise up to be our collaborators and partners.

Be sure you know the condition of your flocks, give careful attention to your herds;

Proverbs 27:23, NIV

We see Jesus also mentoring his disciples and caring for them every step of the way.



PRAYER FIVE: CHRIST

The strongest and most important alliance you need.

This is OUR CORE. The CENTRE that holds us all together. When we are CONNECTED to CHRIST, He will start to divinely align to all other relationships we need.

And Jesus is the DIVINE MENTOR.



WILD FAST

Our Focus this week is **Dealing with Setbacks**.

Setbacks are problems that delay or prevents progress.

Do we all go through setbacks???? Yes! At one point or another, in varying significance, we get to face these setbacks.

How do we handle it????

How we deal with it determines to a large extent how it will affect the quality of our lives. In fact, "*Setbacks are setups for step-ups, when we handle them correctly.*"

The bible records several persons who dealt with setbacks, some multiple times.

Paul, Peter, David, Joseph, Joshua, Moses, Abraham.

These setbacks can be self-caused, or caused by others,

However, our times of setbacks are prime opportunities for God to pour His blessings upon us. Setbacks are God's opportunities to shape us.

"Count it all joy, my brothers when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

James 1:2-4, ESV

"We know that God works to help those people who love him, He uses everything that happens to them to bring something good. He does this for those people that he has chosen to serve him"

Romans 8:28, EASY

PRAYER ONE

"And give thanks for everything to God the Father for everything in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ"

Ephesians 5:20, NLT

I love love love Psalm 100:1-5 in TPT

Lift up a great shout of joy to the Lord! Go ahead and do it— everyone, everywhere! As you serve him, be glad and worship him. Sing your way into his presence with joy! And realize what this really means— we have the privilege of worshiping the Lord our God. For he is our Creator and we belong to him. We are the people of his pleasure. You can pass through his open gates with the password of praise. Come right into his presence with thanksgiving. Come bring your thank offering to him and affectionately bless his beautiful name!

For the Lord is always good and ready to receive you. He's so loving that it will amaze you— so kind that it will astound you! And he is famous for his faithfulness toward all. Everyone knows our God can be trusted, for he keeps his promises to every generation!

You see, when we hear setbacks, it is naturally set to bring dread into our hearts but sisters, God is smarter than the devil and WE are not natural but supernatural beings. So, a peep into the supernatural shows that setbacks are divine setups.

Joseph experienced several setbacks and ended up becoming the Prime Minister of Egypt AND SAVING THE WORLD FROM FAMINE.

David experienced several setbacks and ended up the King of Israel leading them to serve God in a divine model (the tabernacle of David).

Peter experienced a setback and at his comeback, 3000 souls were saved in a day.

Paul experienced setbacks and in each situation, souls were won, and books of the bible were written that benefit us today.

Esther experienced a setback when her people were set up for annihilation.

Israel experienced several setbacks, but God always brought victory... the list is endless.

Let us tell God thank you for every setback we have experienced.

PRAYER TWO

God can handle our honesty!

We have heard several speculations about setbacks - some say it is because of sin that we experience setbacks, others say one didn't pray well enough... Again, the list is endless. This makes it difficult sometimes to adequately process what has happened. We get angry and feel

discouraged but because it is 'Christian', we suppress our emotions and continue with the motions.

God wants us to be honest about our emotions; we can bring it on Him. He knows our truest thoughts anyway so we might as well tell it to Him as we feel it. Rick Warren said, "*when you're honest with God about your emotions, it is an act of worship*". Phew!

Job is a classic example of a man who experienced different types of setbacks ALL IN ONE DAY. His first response is documented thus.

Job stood up and tore his robe in grief. Then he shaved his head and fell to the ground to worship.

Job 1:20, NLT

Job was brutally honest with God and so can we. He said in Job 7:11, NLT

I cannot keep from speaking. I must express my anguish. My bitter soul must complain.

In whatever challenge you are facing currently, God wants your honesty. Let us go to Him in prayer right now, wearing our emotions on our sleeves, and then worshipping His majesty!

PRAYER THREE

Deal with bitterness.

The dictionary meaning of bitterness is *anger or disappointment at being treated unfairly*. It usually is subtle and except one is honest, you rarely identify that you are bitter. Worse still, bitterness against God is usually not seen or accepted even if it exists. We feel entitled to certain privileges and when they don't come, or they came but were snatched from us, we feel deeply disappointed and take it out on our neighbours, friends, family and even God.

Job's friends warned him in Job 36:18

"Don't let your anger and pain you endured make you sneer at God..."

Bitterness will not allow our setbacks work in our favour. No wonder the Psalmist shared in Psalm 139:2-3, TPT

God, I invite your search gaze into my heart. Examine me through and through: find out everything that may be hidden within me. Put me to the test and sift through all my anxious cares. See if there is any path of pain I'm walking on, and lead me back to your glorious, everlasting ways - the path that brings me back to you.

A lot of times, we do not even recognize that we have that bitterness. So we will be praying from a place of honesty, asking the Holy Spirit to highlight every bitterness to us; and as He does, we will ask for forgiveness and cleansing.

PRAYER FOUR

Alliances during setbacks.

The natural/human response during setbacks is 'retreat'. We immediately want to self-protect and so we form a wall around us. This is what the devil wants so badly, to isolate you so he can deal more blows to you. However, God calls us to fellowship especially in the times of setbacks. Fellowship with him and fellowship with believers.

This is not the time to pull away and neglect meeting together, as some have formed the habit of doing. In fact, we should come together and urge each other onward as we anticipate the day dawning.

Hebrews 10:25, TPT

At these times when we face challenges, we need believers to join us in fellowship (prayers). Paul saw great benefit in this and proclaimed:

Because you are praying for me, and the Spirit of Jesus Christ is helping me, I know this trouble will bring my freedom.

Philippians 1:19, NCV

So we are praying for grace not to withdraw during times of setbacks. We are asking God to show us the alliances to make, the believers to fellowship with during these times so that we may declare like Paul declared. And we also are asking God to help us be worthy alliances to others when they need us.

PRAYER FIVE

Soak up God's Promises.

Rick Warren said, "When you can't count on anything else, you can count on God's promises" as contained in His word. God's word is our anchor. With His Word we receive instructions for next steps, we receive light in that fogginess, we are pulled from the miry clay and His word becomes our landing.

Why is this?

God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent; Has He said, and will He not do it? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?

Numbers 23:19

Also, the Glory of Israel will not lie or change His mind; for He is not a man that He should change His mind.

1 Samuel 15:29

So that by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us.

Hebrews 6:18

Joshua gave that testimony when he told the Israelites in Joshua 21:45,
NLT

"Not a single word of all the good promises the Lord had given to the family of Israel was left unfulfilled: everything he had spoken came true"

Now we get practical, let us confess God's promises against all the setbacks we have ever faced. Let us remind ourselves of what God has said about that situation we are currently facing that looks like it won't pass.

WILD FAST

TELEO!!!

Probably not a word we are familiar with, but Jesus and Paul exemplified it with their lives.

See how it featured in their final recorded words.

When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, it is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

John 19:30, KJV

I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith:

2 Timothy 4:7, KJV

Both of them came to their ends, confident that they were emptied of everything God had them on earth to do, even when it was stinkin' HARD

They FINISHED and FINISHED well.

FINISH... TELEO in Greek, means among many things, to perform the last act which completes a process.

Even though we are not about to die, we certainly need to move beyond starting with initial excitement, grragra and adrenaline, and moving into the FINISHING of everything God commits to us per season, and time.

We are not going to be STARTERS and QUITTERS

We are going to be STARTERS and FINISHERS.

Like Jesus, Like Paul.

And this takes the spirit of DISCIPLINE which we are going to be taking as armour into our fast.

Get ready sisters. It's weight training time, and the muscle we are focusing on today is DISCIPLINE and SELF CONTROL

PRAYER ONE

We get right out of the gate by dealing with flesh, which if left unrestrained, can make us excited starters, but absent finishers.

Therefore, I do not run uncertainly (without definite aim). I do not box like one beating the air and striking without an adversary. But [like a boxer] I buffet my body [handle it roughly, discipline it by hardships] and subdue it, for fear that after proclaiming to others the Gospel and things pertaining to it, I myself should become unfit [not stand the test, be unapproved and rejected as a counterfeit].

1 Corinthians 9:26-27, AMPC

This confession below comes wholesale from these verses in many versions so we are going to be speaking it over us.

Confession

Like a true athlete that strives for MASTERY daily, I am DISCIPLINED in training and RESTRICT myself in all things, practicing CONSTANT SELF CONTROL.

I practice self-control in my thoughts, words and actions.

Because I am in a race to win an incorruptible Victor's crown that would last forever, I train like a champion athlete, running with purpose in every step, hard for the finish line, never shadow boxing or throwing aimless punches. I am giving this race everything I have got, not wasting time on frivolities and distractions.

I discipline my body, subdue it like a slave, get it under my control and subjection. I train my body to do what it should, striking a blow if I have to, keeping it under strict subjection.

I handle my flesh roughly, land punches on it, DISCIPLINE it by hardships, and chastise it, redirecting it into servitude.

No sloppy living for me, please.

I am staying alert and in top physical, mental, and spiritual condition, never to be caught napping on this ride, going hard for the WELL DONE, GOOD AND FAITHFUL SERVANT.

So, help me God, in Jesus name, Amen.

PRAYER TWO

Discipline to FOCUS

The discipline to FOCUS on one thing and get it done without distraction is a 21st century super power; what with distractions being very present everywhere we turn.

Oh, but with His help, we can all master FOCUS

Look straight ahead, and fix your eyes on what lies before you. Mark out a straight path for your feet; stay on the safe path. Don't get side-tracked; keep your feet from following evil.

Proverbs 4:25-27, NLT

MSG says *ignore all side show distractions*

Whether it is the distraction of our phones and technology, or humans, we are fighting to focus on our day-to-day tasks, as we obey God with our FLINT STYLE FOCUS.

Because the Sovereign Lord helps me, I will not be disgraced. Therefore, I have set my face like a stone, determined to do his will. And I know that I will not be put to shame.

Isaiah 50:7, NLT

PRAYER THREE

DISCIPLINE FOR SUSTAINED OBEDIENCE

Ah, it's so easy and sweet to start, especially when we have heard from God.

Then it gets REAL.

And HARD.

And we wanna just throw it all away, even argue that maybe God didn't send us.

But nah, we are the SEE-THROUGH kinda chicks.

We start

We stay

We FINISH

I'm pretty sure it got hard for Archippus and homeboy was about to QUIT hence Paul had to send Him a special word

Tell Archippus: "See to it that you complete the ministry you have received in the Lord."

Colossians 4:17, NIV

But that's not only for Bro Archy, it is also for us. Enough quitting. Be FAITHFUL with the last thing God told us to do, until we COMPLETE it.

Yes. Amen.

PRAYER FOUR

DISCIPLINE with our RESOLUTIONS.

Ah, how many of us have resolutions we have dropped already?

Whether it has to do with our marriages, homes, children, personal disciplines, spiritual disciplines, professional courses, etc. We started the year or season with fire and righteous anger. We wrote it all down and even got vision boards. We were going to KILL n CRUSH 'em all.

Then life happened and we let life's wear and tear steady extinguish it. Now we can't even look at that list or board again.

But today though, we will look at them all and receive the spirit of discipline, then put in the work to FINISH IT.

For God did not give us a spirit of timidity (of cowardice, of craven and cringing and fawning fear), but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of calm and well-balanced mind and discipline and self-control.

2 Timothy 1:7, AMPC

I have strength for all things in Christ Who empowers me [I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me; I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency].
Philippians 4:13, AMPC

So then, brace up and reinvigorate and set right your slackened and weakened and drooping hands and strengthen your feeble and palsied and tottering knees, [Isaiah 35:3] for as you keep walking forward on God's paths all your stumbling ways will be divinely healed!

PRAYER FIVE

WE finish how we started.

We give God PROPHETIC praise for 2021 WAS a good YEAR.

The YEAR we didn't just shout *Happy New Year* with joy but the year by December, we were also congratulating ourselves for SHOWING UP every single month, and FINISHING WELL and STRONG.

We TELEO'd!!!!

Our testimony is that of Jerusalem (insert your name).

Just take a look at Zion, will you? Centering our worship in festival feasts! Feast your eyes on Jerusalem, a quiet and permanent place to live. No more pulling up stakes and moving on, no more patched-together lean-tos.

Isaiah 33:20, MSG



Look upon Zion, the city of our set feasts and solemnities! Your eyes shall see Jerusalem, a quiet habitation, a tent that shall not be taken down; not one of its stakes shall ever be pulled up, neither shall any of its cords be broken.

Isaiah 33:20, AMPC

And of Paul

I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith:

2 Timothy 4:7, KJV

And of Jesus

WILD FAST

GOALS

In this Holy Week, we highlight the GOALS in Jesus we just desperately NEED in our lives.

JESUS IS GOALS.

AND our singular GOAL is to be like Jesus.

He is our beginning.

He is our end.

He is everything in between.



So as we fast this week, we focus on a few qualities of the ONE who is the object of our focus: JESUS.

We look at this Son and see the God who cannot be seen. We look at this Son and see God's original purpose in everything created. For everything, absolutely everything, above and below, visible and invisible, rank after rank after rank of angels— everything got started in him and finds its purpose in him. He was there before any of it came into existence and holds it all together right up to this moment. And when it comes to the church, he organizes and holds it together, like a head does a body. He was supreme in the beginning and—leading the resurrection parade—he is supreme in the end. From

beginning to end he's there, towering far above everything, everyone. So spacious is he, so roomy, that everything of God finds its proper place in him without crowding. Not only that, but all the broken and dislocated pieces of the universe—people and things, animals and atoms—get properly fixed and fit together in vibrant harmonies, all because of his death, his blood that poured down from the cross.
Colossians 1:15-18, 18-20, MSG

He is the divine portrait, the true likeness of the invisible God, and the firstborn heir of all creation. For in him was created the universe of things, both in the heavenly realm and on the earth, all that is seen and all that is unseen. Every seat of power, realm of government, principality, and authority—it all exists through him and for his purpose! He existed before anything was made, and now everything finds completion in him. He is the Head of his body, which is the church. And since he is the beginning and the firstborn heir in resurrection, he is the most exalted One, holding first place in everything. For God is satisfied to have all his fullness dwelling in Christ. And by the blood of his cross, everything in heaven and earth is brought back to himself— back to its original intent, restored to innocence again!

Colossians 1:15-20, TPT

PRAYER ONE

We get right out of the gate with immense gratitude for the Cross. It's such a good time to give thanks for He:

Who was betrayed and put to death because of our misdeeds and was raised to secure our justification (our acquittal), [making our account balance and absolving us from all guilt before God].

Romans 4:25, AMPC

And we can pray through with the spoken word from Isaac Wimberley on Katie Jobe's FOREVER

PRAYER TWO

COMPASSION

One quality that preceded every miracle/good deed Jesus did, whether He was healing sicknesses, feeding bread and fish, or dying on the cross...

The Greek word for COMPASSION is *splagchnizomai*. The first part of the word (*splagchna*) means "internal organs," so *splagchnizomai* literally means to be moved so deeply by something that you feel it in the pit of your stomach.

That's how Jesus rolled.

That's how we too should roll.

Whether He was healing the sick

When He went ashore and saw a great throng of people, He had compassion (pity and deep sympathy) for them and cured their sick.

Matthew 14:14, AMPC

Moved with compassion, Jesus reached out and touched him. "I am willing," he said. "Be healed!"

Mark 1:41, NLT

Raising the dead

Now as He approached the city gate, a dead man was being carried out—the only son of his mother, and she was a widow. And a large crowd from the city was with her [in the funeral procession]. When the Lord saw her, He felt [great] compassion for her, and said to her, "Do not weep." And He came up and touched the bier [on which the body rested], and the pallbearers stood still. And He said, "Young man, I say to you, arise [from death]!"

Luke 7:12-14, AMP

Feeding them spiritual food

Jesus saw the huge crowd as he stepped from the boat, and he had compassion on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he began teaching them many things.

Mark 6:34, NLT

Or Feeding them natural food

Then Jesus called His disciples to Him, and said, "I feel compassion for the crowd, because they have been with Me now three days and have nothing [left] to eat; and I do not want to send them away hungry, because they might faint [from exhaustion] on the way [home]."

Matthew 15:32, AMP

Jesus was fuelled by compassion so we need to pray that our hearts are compassionate toward every single cause He has placed in our care and we steward it like He too did all His assignments.

PRAYER THREE

CONFRONTATION

Severally, we think compassion and confrontation are mutually exclusive... Confrontational people are wicked, hehe.

But we see Jesus showing us healthy confrontation when nonsense needs to be dealt with and anyone needed to be called out and to the carpet

What sorrow awaits you teachers of religious law and you Pharisees. Hypocrites! Blind guides! What sorrow awaits you!

Blind fools! Which is more important—the gold or the Temple that makes the gold sacred?

Matthew 23:13, 16-17, NLT

(The whole of Mathew 13 is a CALL OUT but the specifics are not as important as is the PRINCIPLES... He wasn't afraid to confront sin).

Upon entering Jerusalem Jesus went directly into the temple area and drove away all the merchants who were buying and selling their goods. He overturned the tables of the money changers and the stands of those selling doves. And he said to them, "My dwelling

place will be known as a house of prayer, but you have made it into a hangout for thieves!

Matthew 21:12-13, TPT

PRAYER FOUR

DISCERNMENT

Jesus was discerning and had foresight. He was not one to be deceived and we know this came from spending time with the Father.

Whether it was in choosing His disciples

After leaving the synagogue, Jesus went into the high hills to spend the whole night in prayer to God. At daybreak, he called together all of his followers and selected twelve from among them, and he appointed them to be his apostles.

Luke 6:12-13, TPT

Discerning what to do with the fickle praise of men

While Jesus was at the Passover Feast, the number of his followers began to grow, and many gave their allegiance to him because of all the miraculous signs they had seen him doing! PRAYER ONE

Nathaneal: PURE HEART GOALS

One of the lesser-known disciples, the first time we see him, Jesus Himself was endorsing him:

A quick check to other versions and we see such adjectives used to qualify dude and his heart as:

No deceit, falsehood or duplicity.

No hidden motive

A man of complete integrity
An honest man

David's prayer was Nathanael's reality AND our GOAL.

Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden part thou shalt make me to know wisdom. Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.

PRAYER TWO

Epaphras: INTERCESSION GOALS

Epaphras, who is also from Colossae, sends his loving greetings. I can tell you that he is a true servant of Christ, who always labours and intercedes for you. His prayers are filled with requests to God that you would grow and mature, standing complete and perfect in the beauty of God's plan for your lives. INTERCESSION

FIRST OF all, then, I admonish and urge that petitions, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be offered on behalf of all men, For kings and all who are in positions of authority or high responsibility, that [outwardly] we may pass a quiet and undisturbed life [and inwardly] a peaceable one in all godliness and reverence and seriousness in every way. For such [praying] is good and right, and [it is] pleasing and acceptable to God our Saviour, Who wishes all men to be saved and [increasingly] to perceive and recognize and discern and know precisely and correctly the [divine] Truth.

So let's intercede...

PRAYER ONE

If I regard sin and baseness in my heart [that is, if I know it is there and do nothing about it], The Lord will not hear [me];

We need fresh fires in our marriages. We need to fight the indifference. We need to fight familiarity. In summary we need WISDOM.

If any of you lacks wisdom [to guide him through a decision or circumstance], he is to ask of [our benevolent] God, who gives to everyone generously and without rebuke or blame, and it will be given to him.

James 1:5, AMP

PRAYER FOUR

We pray for Nigeria

It is obvious from the fierceness of the battles that face Nigeria as a nation and Nigerians as a people that it is a nation treasured by God and a major player in His end time agenda.

That's because the devil doesn't waste time on anything that is not key to God's agenda. The battle over Nigeria is a spiritual one and we cannot fight a spiritual battle with the arm of flesh.

For we are not wrestling with flesh and blood [contending only with physical opponents], but against the despotisms, against the powers, against [the master spirits who are] the world rulers of this present darkness, against the spirit forces of wickedness in the heavenly (supernatural) sphere.

Ephesians 6:12, AMPC

So, we do not join others to curse the government; no no no. God has given us understanding and discernment. So, we choose to partner with God in establishing His sovereignty over our nation Nigeria and all its spheres of governance.

With one voice we declare YHWH as the Sovereign King over Nigeria.

Only His name is glorified over Nigeria,

Only His will stands,

Only His purposes are fulfilled,

Only those who He has appointed get to lead.

And only by His Spirit are Nigerians led.

His Voice is exalted above every other voice

Only His decree is established.

Only His justice prevails.

Remember what I accomplished in antiquity! Truly I am God, I have no peer; I am God, and there is none like me, who announces the end from the beginning and reveals beforehand what has not yet occurred, who says, 'My plan will be realized, I will accomplish what I desire,' who summons an eagle from the east, from a distant land, one who carries out my plan. Yes, I have decreed, yes, I will bring it to pass; I have formulated a plan, yes, I will carry it out.

Epaphras, a member of your own fellowship and a servant of Christ Jesus, sends you his greetings. He always prays earnestly for you, asking God to make you strong and perfect, fully confident that you are following the whole will of God. I can assure you that he prays hard for you and also for the believers in Laodicea and Hierapolis.
Colossians 4:12-13, NLT

Someone you have been indifferent about their prayer-needing conditions at best, or judgmental of them at worst.

Now we will first repent. Then ask the Lord to PLACE A PRAYER BURDEN and DEMAND on us for this person and WE COMMIT to seeing it through.

My little children, for whom I am again suffering birth pangs until Christ is completely and permanently formed (moulded) within you,
Galatians 4:19, AMPC

Note: You are not exactly praying for them, you are asking the Lord to show you HOW to pray for them as a project until you see results or the burden lifts, because this is not a 15 minutes prayer point.

He is about to deploy us into prayer city and we need the tools and strategies.

Now, we download them.

The next day as they were still on their way and were approaching the town, Peter went up to the roof of the house to pray, about the sixth hour (noon).

And Cornelius said, this is now the fourth day since about this time I was observing the ninth hour (three o'clock in the afternoon) of prayer in my lodging place; [suddenly] a man stood before me in dazzling apparel, And he said, Cornelius, your prayer has been heard and harkened to, and your donations to the poor have been known and preserved before God [so that He heeds and is about to help you].

Acts 10:9, 30-31, AMPC

Then we once again establish our oneness in communion together and round up.



FRIDAY, 16 APRIL, 2021

WILD FIRE

Tonight, we go a little deeper in intercession.

WORSHIP

PRAYER ONE: INTERCESSION FOR HEALTH

We are praying for divine healing and health.

Sound health is our inheritance, it is part of the package we received at salvation. It is not God's plan for any of his children to be sick. So we will be interceding for anyone we know with one ailment or the other.

Sickness is not our portion as God's children and most times, it has a spiritual undertone to it. We will declare healing by the stripes of Jesus for anyone that is sick. He took our shame, diseases and nailed it to the cross already. We have been healed.

We are praying for divine/supernatural healing for every sick person we know. Let us call those sickness by name and ask them to "get out" of God's temple.

"He himself bore our sins" in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; "by his wounds you have been healed."

1 Peter 2:24, NIV

*And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven.
James 5:15, NIV*

*I have seen his [wilful] ways, but I will heal him; I will lead him also and will recompense him and restore comfort to him and to those who mourn for him. [Isaiah 61:1, 2; 66:10].
Isaiah 57:18, AMPC*

*But for you who fear My name [with awe-filled reverence] the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings. And you will go forward and leap [joyfully] like calves [released] from the stall.
Malachi 4:2, AMP*

Let's remember that no sickness is greater than God.

*Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh; is there anything too hard for Me?
Jeremiah 32:27, AMPC*

Now that we have prayed for the sick, there is another dimension and this is enjoying Divine health. This is God's ultimate plan for His Children. A situation where we are insulated against any form of disease and sickness.

Let's declare no disease or sickness comes near anyone we know.

Let's mount a shield of protection using our words of Faith.

Beloved friend, I pray that you are prospering in every way and that you continually enjoy good health, just as your soul is prospering.

3 John 1:2, TPT

The LORD will take away from you all sickness; and He will not subject you to any of the harmful diseases of Egypt which you have known, but He will impose them on all [those] who hate you.

Deuteronomy 7:15, AMP

"But you—you serve your GOD and he'll bless your food and your water. I'll get rid of the sickness among you; there won't be any miscarriages nor barren women in your land. I'll make sure you live full and complete lives."

PRAYER TWO: INTERCESSION FOR MARRIAGES

Following from our fast focus, we started off by asking for wisdom. We will dwell on wisdom a bit.

The wisdom spoken of in James 1:5 is Sophia (pronounced So-fee-aa); this means lowly, highly, worldly or spiritual wisdom. It denotes practical wisdom. This is instruction or direction for every situation.

James tells the Church to ask for this kind of wisdom in their trials. So in our everyday life, we do not fall into the rut of indifference, we must optimize every opportunity we find ourselves in and turn it in our favour. We are to **ACTIVELY** ask for wisdom.

Now the challenge is not in asking, but in the persistence in asking. We give up too easily at the face of challenges. We are quick to conclude that maybe it is the will of God.

God wants us to persistently ask. It is not the 2 minutes in the morning asking for wisdom, not when we remember, not when we have exhausted other options kind of prayer. God wants us to progress from ask, to knock, to seeking for Sophia.

Our focus this moment is in asking for grace to **STAY** receiving **AND** acting on the wisdom we receive. We are also asking for the right attitude during the waiting period, we are asking for the right mindset and words.



And don't allow yourselves to be weary or disheartened in planting good seeds, for the season of reaping the wonderful harvest you've planted is coming!

Galatians 6:9, TPT

We pray in 2 parts

First, for marriages other than ours that are suffering from indifference and are on the rocks. Let's ask God to intervene. Let God turn these marriages around and make them honourable.

Then we ask for wisdom for those areas in our marriages that we HAD decided to sweep under the carpet - the areas we are not fully maximizing or enjoying full benefits; Spiritual leadership in the home, sex, finances, parenting, companionship/communication, infidelity, etc.

We can come to God with no doubts. This means that when we ask God for things (and those things agree with what God wants for us), God cares about what we say. He listens to us every time we ask him. So we know that he gives us whatever we ask from him.

1 John 5:14-15, ERV

PRAYER THREE: INTERCESSION FOR NIGERIA

Super excited to be praying for Nigeria.

So ladies before we go into a session of prayer, we would be releasing Nigeria from the hurt it has caused us (be it directly or indirectly). We will forgive Nigeria just as our Father forgives us. We are doing this so that we can wholeheartedly pray for our beloved country without reservations.

This is time for us to declare the Lordship of our Father over Nigeria. Nigeria belongs to the Lord. Nigeria is owned by God.

Let us declare that as long as Nigeria exists,

Nigeria is devoted to God

Nigeria is obedient to God

Nigeria is dedicated to God

The authority of the name of Jesus causes every knee to bow in reverence! Everything and everyone will one day submit to this name—in the heavenly realm, in the earthly realm, and in the demonic realm. And every tongue will proclaim in every language: "Jesus Christ is Lord Yahweh," bringing glory and honour to God, his Father!
Philippians 2:10-11, TPT

For this very reason the Anointed One died and was brought back to life again, so that he would become the Lord God over both the dead and the living.
Romans 14:9, TPT

PRAYER ONE

Prayer Focus: Unforgiveness with its root in offense.

And the antidote to cleansing my heart of this is Love. God highlighted the study of the fruit of the Spirit to me and made Love the major one out of the nine for me. According to 1 Corinthians 13, if I have Love, I have all it takes to not take offense and forgive no matter what.

An understanding person demonstrates patience, for mercy means holding your tongue. When you are insulted, be quick to forgive and forget it, for you are virtuous when you overlook an offense.

Proverbs 19:11, TPT

You must not hurt another person because he hurt you. And you must not remember for a long time the bad thing that someone did to you. You must love all people as you love yourself. I am the Lord.

Leviticus 19:18, EASY

It is not conceited (arrogant and inflated with pride); it is not rude (unmannerly) and does not act unbecomingly. God has promised to take care of you. Think seriously about how you live. Watch carefully for danger. Remember that the Devil is your enemy. He wants to hurt you. He walks about like a hungry lion. Love is large and incredibly patient. Love is gentle and consistently kind to all. It refuses to be jealous when blessing comes to someone else. Love does not brag about one's achievements nor inflate its own importance. Love does not traffic in shame and disrespect, nor selfishly seek its own honour. Love is not easily irritated or quick to take offense. Love joyfully celebrates honesty and finds no delight in what is wrong. Love is a safe place of shelter, for it never stops believing the best for others. Love never takes failure as defeat, for it never gives up.

1 Corinthians 13:4-7, TPT

God is love. When we take up permanent residence in a life of love, we live in God and God lives in us. This way, love has the run of the house, becomes at home and mature in us, so that we're free of worry on Judgment Day—our standing in the world is identical with Christ's. PRAYER THREE

The Holy Spirit has begun a good work in us, purifying us and making us new. We were told from the beginning that this fight is not a physical one and this is strengthened in the scripture in Ephesians 6v12 when the bible says;

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
Ephesians 6:12, KJV

Therefore, we will continually be faced with temptations to be angry, to be cynical, envious, keep offence, be hypocrites and unfaithful to God- the list is endless. To watch against these onslaughts the bible has shown us the resources God has at our disposal. Because of that, take all the help that God gives, like it is your armour. Then, when the bad time comes, you will be able to stand strongly. You will not fall. After you have finished everything, you will still be standing strongly in your place.

Ephesians 6:13, EASY

Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

The "take" in the scriptures is from the Greek word "analabete", which comes from 2 Greek words "ana" and "lambano". (2983 lambánō (from the primitive root, lab-, meaning "actively lay hold of to take or receive," see NAS dictionary) - properly, to lay hold by aggressively (actively) accepting what is available (offered). 2983 /lambánō ("accept with initiative") emphasizes the volition (assertiveness) of the receiver.)

So, we will pray in the Holy Spirit at this time, and *lambano* this help the Father has made available

PRAYER FOUR

Let's pray all the armour of God into our lives.

Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

Short but powerful phrase from one disciple to Jesus

And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.

Luke 11:1, KJV

It's amazing that these ones saw Jesus do INCREDIBLE miracles, from raising the dead, to healing the sick, feeding multitudes, calming a dead sea and more, the disciples wanted to learn HOW TO PRAY instead from Jesus.

That profound lesson is not lost on us, so if it's OK, we will be highlighting a couple areas of life and asking the FATHER to TEACH US TO PRAY.

An 'intercessory petition' if you like...

Why is this important?

Because it is only prayers done in accordance to HIS WILL that gets answered.

And this is the confidence (the assurance, the privilege of boldness) which we have in Him: [we are sure] that if we ask anything (make any request) according to His will (in agreement with His own plan),

He listens to and hears us. And if (since) we [positively] know that He listens to us in whatever we ask, we also know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that we have [granted us as our present possessions] the requests made of Him.

1 John 5:14-15, AMPC

So we are not here on earth to shoot rubber bullets against a raging enemy. We wanna pray focused, targeted, powerful, word-based and 'taught by Jesus' prayers.

Prayers that HIT THE MARK.

We are not just praying today, we are receiving PRAYER STRATEGIES that will last us for a prayer season, which is why this is a combination of both INTERCESSION and PETITION.

Ready, Set, PRAAAAAAY

I solemnly urge you in the presence of God and Christ Jesus, who will someday judge the living and the dead when he comes to set up his Kingdom: Preach the word of God. Be prepared, whether the time

is favourable or not. Patiently correct, rebuke, and encourage your people with good teaching. For a time is coming when people will no longer listen to sound and wholesome teaching.
