leaders among the people. The Spirit said to me, "Son of man, these are the men who are planning evil and giving wicked counsel in this city. They say to the people, 'Is it not a good time to build houses? This city is like an iron pot. We are safe inside it like meat in a pot.' Therefore, son of man, prophesy against them loudly and clearly." Then the Spirit of the Lord came upon me, and he told me to say, "This is what the Lord says to the people of Israel: I know what you are saying, for I know every thought that comes into your minds. You have murdered many in this city and filled its streets with the dead. "Therefore, this is what the Sovereign Lord says: This city is an iron pot all right, but the pieces of meat are the victims of your injustice. As for you, I will soon drag you from this pot. I will bring on you the sword of war you so greatly fear, says the Sovereign Lord. I will drive you out of Jerusalem and hand you over to foreigners, who will carry out my judgments against you. You will be slaughtered all the way to the borders of Israel. I will execute judgment on you, and you will know that I am the Lord. No, this city will not be an iron pot for you, and you will not be like meat safe inside it. I will judge you even to the borders of Israel, and you will know that I am the Lord. For you have refused to obey my decrees and regulations; instead, you have copied the standards of the nations around you." While I was still prophesying, Pelatiah son of Benaiah suddenly died. Then I fell face down on the ground and cried out, "O Sovereign Lord, are you going to kill everyone in Israel?" Ezekiel 11:1-13, NLT

**TUESDAY, MAY 25, 2021**

**PRAYER:**

For every King, there's a prophet.

God is so interested in the affairs of nations that He doesn't leave any King, President, Governor, Prime minister without a Prophet – a channel of revelation. For by strength shall no man prevail (1 Samuel 2:9).

And

*“Where there is no vision [no redemptive revelation of God], the people perish; but he who keeps the law [of God, which includes that of man]–blessed (happy, fortunate, and enviable) is he. [1 Samuel 3:1; Amos 8:11, 12.]”* Proverbs 29:18, AMPC

We have a cloud of witnesses in all the Kings of Israel and Judah notwithstanding their spiritual position.

King David had Prophet Nathan (2 Samuel 12).

King Nebuchadnezzar had Prophet Daniel (Daniel 2).

King Ahab had Prophet Micaiah and Prophet Elijah (2 Chronicles 18, 1 Kings 17-22)

King Jehu had Prophet Elisha (2 Kings 9-17)

King Hezekiah had Prophet Isaiah (2 Kings 18)

Pharaoh had Joseph (Genesis 41)

Rehoboam had Prophet Shemaiah (1 Kings 12)

So, we rouse the prophets set over the Presidency in Nigeria from their slumber. No longer will they be mute or speak from the sides of their mouth. We pray over them the Spirit of boldness to speak to power without fear, the exact message the Lord has given them. No longer will they fall victim to greed and selfishness.

**SCRIPTURES**

*“Therefore, He says, Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall shine (make day dawn) upon you and give you light.”* Ephesians 5:14, AMPC

*“And Jehoshaphat said to the king of Israel, inquire first, I pray you, for the word of the Lord today. So, King [Ahab] of Israel gathered together the*

prophets, 400 men, and said to them, shall we go to Ramoth-Gilead to battle, or shall I forbear? And they said, go up, for God will deliver it into the king's hand. But Jehoshaphat said, is there not another prophet of the Lord here by whom we may inquire? King [Ahab] of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, there is another man, Micaiah son of Imla, by whom we may inquire of the Lord, but I hate him, for he never has prophesied good for me, but always evil. And Jehoshaphat said, let not the king say so. And King [Ahab] of Israel called for one of his officers and said, Bring quickly Micaiah son of Imla. And Zedekiah son of Chenaanah had made himself horns of iron, and said, thus says the Lord: With these you shall push the Syrians until they are destroyed. All the prophets prophesied so, saying, go up to Ramoth-Gilead and prosper; the Lord will deliver it into the king's hand. The messenger who went to call Micaiah said to him, Behold, the words of the prophets foretell good to the king with one accord. So, let your word be like one of them, and speak favourably. But Micaiah said, As the Lord lives, what my God says, that will I speak. And when he had come to the king, King [Ahab] said to him, Micaiah, shall we go to Ramoth-Gilead to battle, or shall I forbear? And he said, go up and prosper, and they shall be delivered into your hand. And the king said to him, how many times shall I warn you to tell nothing but the truth to me in the name of the Lord? Then Micaiah said, I did see all Israel scattered upon the mountains as sheep that have no shepherd, and the Lord said, these have no master. Let each return to his house in peace. And King [Ahab] of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, Did I not tell you that he would not prophesy good to me, but evil? [Micaiah] said, therefore, hear the word of the Lord: I saw the Lord sitting on His throne, and all the host of heaven standing at His right hand and His left.

And the Lord said, who shall entice Ahab king of Israel, that he may go up and fall at Ramoth-Gilead? And one said this thing, and another that. Then there came a spirit and stood before the Lord and said, I will entice him. The Lord said to him, by what means? And he said, I will go out and be a lying spirit in the mouths of all his prophets. And the Lord said, You shall entice him and also succeed. Go forth and do so. Now, you see, the Lord put a lying spirit in the mouths of your prophets; and the Lord has spoken evil concerning you. Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah came near and smote Micaiah upon the cheek and said, which way went the Spirit of the Lord from me to speak to you? And Micaiah said, Behold, you shall see on that day when you shall go into an inner chamber to hide yourself. Then King [Ahab] of Israel said, Take Micaiah back to Amon the governor of the city and to Joash the king's son, and say, thus says the king: Put this fellow in prison and feed him with bread and water of affliction until I return in peace. Micaiah said, if you return at all in peace, the Lord has not spoken by me. And he [added], Hear it, you people, all of you! So, Ahab king of Israel and Jehoshaphat king of Judah went up to Ramoth-Gilead.

A certain man drew his bow at a venture and smote King [Ahab] of Israel between the lower armour and the breastplate. So, Ahab said to his chariot driver, turn, carry me out of the battle, for I am wounded. And the battle increased that day; however, King [Ahab] of Israel propped himself up in his chariot opposite the Syrians until evening, and about sunset he died.” 2 Chronicles 18:4-8, 10-28, 33-34, AMPC



One part of this Revival that struck me was a man wanted to murder a woman and then commit suicide but upon hearing someone preach, he shouted, "what shall I do to be saved?" Kai.... there is no situation God cannot change!

### **PRAYER 1**

Revival brings about the Revelation of God. Like, there is such a God consciousness, an awareness of His Holiness, His glory, His Mercy, His Majesty.

God, we ask that you move over our Nation Nigeria.

### **SCRIPTURES**

*"Lord, I have heard of your fame; I stand in awe of your deeds, Lord. Repeat them in our day, in our time make them known; in wrath remember mercy." Habakkuk 3:2, NIVUK*

*"In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw [in a vision] the Lord sitting on a throne, high and exalted, with the train of His royal robe filling the [most holy part of the] temple. Above Him seraphim (heavenly beings) stood; each one had six wings: with two wings he covered his face, with two wings he covered his feet, and with two wings he flew. And one called out to another, saying, "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of hosts; The whole earth is filled with His glory." And the foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him who called out, and the temple was filling with smoke. Then I said, "Woe is me! For I am ruined, Because I am a man of [ceremonially] unclean lips, And I live among a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts." Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs. ## **PRAYER 1**

**TUESDAY, AUGUST 31, 2021**

**PRAYER 2**

Responding Appropriately

*“But we prayed to our God and kept men on guard against them day and night. The people of Judah had a song they sang: “We grow weak carrying burdens; There's so much rubble to take away. How can we build the wall today?” Our enemies thought we would not see them or know what was happening until they were already upon us, killing us and putting an end to our work. But time after time Jews who were living among our enemies came to warn us of the plans our enemies were making against us. So I armed the people with swords, spears, and bows, and stationed them by clans behind the wall, wherever it was still unfinished. I saw that the people were worried, so I said to them and to their leaders and officials, “Don't be afraid of our enemies. Remember how great and terrifying the Lord is, and fight for your relatives, your children, your wives, and your homes.” Our enemies heard that we had found out what they were plotting, and they realized that God had defeated their plans. Then all of us went back to rebuilding the wall.” Nehemiah 4:9-15, GNT*

**THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 2021**

I am reminded about Psalm 121:2 – *“My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth!”*

We are praying to our Almighty Father, our helper; such an assurance!

If you have been seeing the news, the one major thing that will grip you is the violence. But we have the weapon – The Word of God, that powerful Word that change any and every situation.

We are putting an end to the festering violence with the all-powerful Word of God.

## PRAYER 1

From the East to the West, North to the south, we release Angels to contend with those contending with Nigeria.

We release Angels to pursue and scatter them in seven ways.

We release confusion into their midst. We declare confusion and unrest onto the camp of people hindering Nigerians from living peaceably in their homes.

## **SCRIPTURES**

*“The Lord shall cause your enemies who rise up against you to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways.” Deuteronomy 28:7, AMPC*

*“For thus says the Lord: Even the captives of the mighty will be taken away, and the prey of the terrible will be delivered; for I will contend with him who contends with you, and I will give safety to your children and ease them.” Isaiah 49:25, AMPC*

*“My people will build houses and they will live in them. They will plant vineyards and they will eat the fruit from them.” Isaiah 65:21, EASY*

## **PRAYER 2**

Walking in the Power and Authority that we have:

We are a people of power and authority. We are a people that God has given power to overcome the enemy.

Oh, that our spiritual eyes and understanding be opened to not only see but understand and walk in the power of God available and at work on our behalf.

That we will rise and walk in the authority that God has given to us, without fear or doubt.

## **SCRIPTURES**

*headship exercised throughout the church], [Ps. 8:6.] Which is His body, the fullness of Him Who fills all in all [for in that body lives the full measure of Him Who makes everything complete, and Who fills everything everywhere with Himself].” Ephesians 1:18-23, AMPC*

*“Now you understand that I have imparted to you my authority to trample over his kingdom. You will trample upon every demon before you and overcome every power Satan possesses. Absolutely nothing will harm you as you walk in this authority.” Luke 10:19, TPT*

*“Behold! I have given you authority and power to trample upon serpents and scorpions, and [physical and mental strength and ability] over all the power that the enemy [possesses]; and nothing shall in any way harm you.” Luke 10:19, AMPC*

**TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 7, 2021**

### **PRAYER 1**

I was reading the news and I saw that within the year, over 30,000 people have been declared missing. The thing about numbers is that it doesn't put emotions or faces to the issue.

Let's think about it, those are people's family members: brother, sister, son, daughter, father, mother, wife, husband... I could go on.

We come with the authority we have in God and we put an end to these operations of darkness.
